GIO PONTI settled between horses then outside a rival, came out into the stretch and again in upper stretch and rallied under some urging to get up on the wire. VENTURA chased inside, came out on the second turn and four wide into the stretch, bid five wide in midstretch, gained the lead past midstretch and was caught on the line. DIXIE CHATTER three deep early, angled in on the first turn and stalked inside, came out leaving the second turn and a bit wide into the stretch, gained the advantage four wide in midstretch, fought back between horses in the final furlong and continued willingly. GLOBAL HUNTER (ARG) settled outside a rival, came out into the stretch and rallied between horses in the drive. ARTISTE ROYAL (IRE) settled a bit off the rail then inside, moved up just off the fence into the stretch, steadied in tight off heels in midstretch, then split foes and was outfinished. MR NAPPER TANDY (GB) saved ground chasing the pace, came out into the stretch, bid between horses in midstretch and was outfinished. BECRUX (ITY) chased three deep then outside a rival, came four wide into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. VICTORY PETE hopped a bit at the start, chased three deep then outside a rival, went three wide on the second turn and four wide into the stretch and could not summon the necessary response. WISE RIVER stalked the pace off the rail then bid outside a rival and dueled for the lead, was between horses in midstretch and weakened. HEWITTS angled in and sped to the early lead, set the pace inside, dueled along the rail on the backstretch and second turn, fought back to midstretch, then weakened.
