Vale(BRZ). FLUKE (BRZ) a bit off the rail into the first turn, angled in and chased inside, moved up along the rail into the stretch, bid inside in

midstretch, gained the lead past the eighth pole, inched clear and held on gamely under urging. CARACORTADO settled a bit off the rail and

went around the broke down horse into the backstretch, chased inside, came out for room and three deep into the stretch, split horses in the

drive and rallied gamely while between foes on the line. JERANIMO three deep early, chased outside a rival, went three wide leaving the

second turn and into the stretch and closed willingly. TIMES GONE BY three wide nearing the first turn, angled in off the rail then found the fence to stalk the pace on the backstretch, came out into the stretch and could not offer the necessary late kick. ACCLAMATION had speed outside a rival then inched away early on the backstretch, angled in and set the pace inside, fought back leaving the second turn and between horses in midstretch and weakened some late. SEBASTIAN FLYTE (GB) pulled between horses then chased a bit off the rail, continued inside

on the second turn and into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. GALLANT SON chased three deep then outside a rival, came out leaving the second turn and five wide into the stretch and could not summon the necessary response. LIBERIAN FREIGHTER had speed inside to duel for the lead, came out and pulled while stalking the pace a bit off the rail, bid again alongside ACCLAMATION on the second turn and into the stretch, was three deep in midstretch and weakened. SQUARE EDDIE stalked outside then off the rail, went three deep leaving the second turn and four wide into the stretch and also weakened. LIEVE (BRZ) between horses early, angled in on the first turn, broke down behind into
