Bay Colt, (Feb), by Bellamy Road - Queen of Empire by Empire Maker. Trainer Pletcher A. Todd. Bred by Robert Muir, Des Scott & Sam Klein(KY).

KING CYRUS was away fast from the outside post, showed good speed then tracked the pace on the outside, chose the four path while confidently handled on the turn, drew alongside the leaders in the process, was asked a bit when threatened from behind by ASLAN outside the quarter-pole, easily shook clear when roused at the top of the stretch, drew away while being flagged with the whip into the final furlong, was given two cracks of a right-handed whip while drifting out a touch inside the eighth-pole, regained a straighter course shortly thereafter and proved much the best while hand urged in the final sixteenth. ASLAN was ridden along while off the pace, went four wide early on the turn then dropped to the three path, advanced coming to the five-sixteenths pole, waited while hesitant to take a seam between the leading trio outside the quarter-pole, was put to a drive while four wide into the stretch, drifted in near the furlong marker while chasing the winner and proved no match then was eased up late while clearly second best. KINGOFGOLDSTREET moved up to take the lead, set the pace under pressure, vied inside on the turn, lost touch with the winner at the top of the stretch, dropped back under a right-handed whip and tired while able to hold the show. SOUPERFAST broke a bit slow, was ridden along on the outside, angled in midway down the backstretch, raced inside early on the turn then came off the rail, shifted four wide late on the bend, came under the whip in upper stretch and failed to threaten. TIGHTLY BRIDLED broke a half-step slow, was hustled then moved up to press the pace, drew even with the leader on the turn, dropped back under a drive into upper stretch and faded. HIGH RANSOM broke a half-step slow, drifted out entering the main-track, lacked any speed, went two then three wide early on the turn, moved to five wide near the quarter-pole and was no factor.
