under a drive. FIFTY PROOF pulled to a short early lead, was pressured on the backstretch and early turn, entertained a challenge late turn,

was headed at the top of the stretch then finished determinedly, but hung late. SOCIETY'S CHAIRMAN settled off the pace along the rail,

angled between foes upper stretch and rallied gamely. ARTIC FERN stalked the pace, came three to five-wide through the turn, chased into the stretch then evened out in the late stages. HAILSTONE, rated off the pace, saved ground then rallied from last at the top of the stretch. GRAND ADVENTURE forced the pace into the turn, challenged late turn, shook clear at the top of the stretch, was all out but weakened in the

late stages. HOLLINGER, rated midpack, saved ground, chased into the stretch, finished all out but was not a threat. WOODBOURNE, prominent to the turn, stayed in range but lacked a rally. SILVER ROCK, rated off the pace, angled out early backstretch, was hustled four to six-wide through the turn then finished all out. WORKIN FOR HOPS raced off the pace, came three to six-wide through the turn but was never in contention. MERKABAH raced midpack along the rail, was hustled on the turn then lacked a rally.
