Non-winners of a Grade I race at a mile or over in 2010-2011, allowed 3 lbs.; Of a Grade II race at a mile or over in 2010-2011, allowed 5 lbs.; Of a Grade III race at a mile or over in 2010-2011, allowed 7 lbs.; Of a Sweepstakes of \$60,000 at a mile or over in 2010-2011, allowed 9 lbs.; (No Canadian Bred Allowance) (Note: Grades as recognized by the International Cataloguing Standards Committee) Final entries to made through the entry box at the closing time then in effect for overnight events. A supplemental nomination may be made no later than the time of final entry, by a non-refundable fee of \$5,000, which includes the entry fee. COURT OF THE REALM, in touch early, was hustled angling from the rail to three-wide late turn, rallied gamely and got up in deep stretch under a drive. **FIFTY PROOF** pulled to a short early lead, was pressured on the backstretch and early turn, entertained a challenge late turn, was headed at the top of the stretch then finished determinedly, but hung late. **SOCIETY'S CHAIRMAN** settled off the pace along the rail, angled between foes upper stretch and rallied gamely. **ARTIC FERN** stalked the pace, came three to five-wide through the turn, chased into the stretch then evened out in the late stages. **HAILSTONE**, rated off the pace, saved ground then rallied from last at the top of the stretch. **GRAND ADVENTURE** forced the pace into the turn, challenged late turn, shook clear at the top of the stretch, was all out but weakened in the late stages. **HOLLINGER**, rated midpack, saved ground, chased into the stretch, finished all out but was not a threat. **WOODBOURNE**, prominent to the turn, stayed in range but lacked a rally. **SILVER ROCK**, rated off the pace, angled out early backstretch, was hustled four to six-wide through the turn then finished all out. **WORKIN FOR HOPS** raced off the pace, came three to six-wide through the turn but was never in contention. **MERKABAH** raced midpack along the rail, was hustled on the turn then lacked a rally.
