2- BEAUTYINTHEPULPIT . . .

ZIVO away in good order, loped along the inside, side by side with AWESIOME VISION for the majority of the way to the end of the backstretch, got eased off the rail after going three-quarters, fanned wider and wider after turning for home until six to seven wide by the end of the maneuver, settled into his best stride and picked up ground readily, got engaged in a spirited tussle with another pair to the inside, outgamed them, despite getting bumped prior to the wire to prove best. SINISTRA assumed a forward position right from the get-go, was rated in the two path while prompting the leader for almost six furlongs, got set down for the drive home, forged his way to a narrow advantage during the run from upper to midstretch, fought gamely to preserve it while being stiffly challenged by another twosome to his right, started to come outward in final sixteenth, did so more readily after having the rider momentarily utilize some left handed stick work, wound up carrying out and bumping with BEAUTYINTHEPULPIT in the shadow of the wire, got nipped at the end. BEAUTYINTHEPULPIT lunged inward after taking an awkward initial step, nearly making significant contact with the gate, pulled on the bit for much of the way towards the opening turn, was reserved off the inside within striking distance, swung into the stretch under urging, emerged locked in battle between rivals leaving the sixteenth marker, got gradually and steadily herded out by the second place finisher, eventually getting bumped from both sides and pinched back a couple of jumps before the finish line. AWESOME VISION tipped three wide into the backstretch, was under a drive by the five-sixteenths marker, failed to make the needed headway. MONEYINYOUR POCKET contently tracked the front runners from the pocket, kept at it being put to some light hand urging on the second bend, angled three wide into the stretch, failed to fire after getting called upon. COMANDANTE out broke the field, was put to a firm hold and placed along the inside route before reaching the end of the homestretch, continued to be rated along for nearly three-quarters, entered the stretch and was asked for run, showed good determination before relinquishing near the furlong marker, weakened steadily thereafter. Following a Stewards' Inquiry focusing on the stretch run as well as a claim of foul lodged by the trainer of BEAUTYINTHEPULPIT against the rider of the SINASTRA alleging interference in the stretch, the result
