1 MILE. (Turf) (1.313) STAKES. Purse \$100,000 *KINGSTON S. FOR THREE YEAR OLDS AND UPWARD FOAL*ED IN NEW YORK STATE AND APPROVED BY THE NEW YORK STATE-BRED REGISTRY. No nomination fee. \$500 to pass the entry box and an additional \$500 to start. A supplemental nomination fee of \$1,000 in addition to the entry and starting fees may be made at any time prior to the closing of entries. The purse will be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally among remaining finishers. Three Year Olds, 118 lbs. Older , 123. TURF. Non-winners of a sweepstakes twice on the turf since September 1, 2010 allowed 3 lbs.; such a race on the turf since than, 5 lbs.; four races on the turf, 7 lbs.; DIRT. Non-winners of a Sweepstake at a mile or over on the dirt in 2011 allowed 3 lbs.; a sweepstake at a mile or over on the dirt since September 1, 2010, 5 lbs.; four races on the dirt, 7 lbs. (Maiden, claiming and starter races not considered). A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. The New York Racing Association reserves the right to transfer this race to the Main Track. Closed Saturday, May 14, 2011 with 31 Nominations. (If the Stewards consider it inadvisable to run this race on the turf course, this race will be run at One Mile on the main track.). (Clear 78)

POCKET COWBOYS broke well and established control, without need of being asked for speed, carved the pace, from the inside, well rated but facing some pressure from the nearest pursuer, continued along under the same conditions until upper stretch, got called upon shortly before LUBASH was, left the eighth pole, still holding a safe advantage, then proceeded to edge away from that opponent, crossing the wire under a brisk hand ride. LUBASH pressed the pacesetter from the outside until upper stretch, got called upon, kept abreast until the sixteenth pole, lost contact but continued onward with good courage to be second best. SPA CITY FEVER three wide at the three-eighths pole, proved no match for the top twosome. SCIENTIST saved ground around the turn and made no serious bids. PRETTY BOY FREUD urged cutting the corner into the lane, angled outward in the vicinity of the eighth pole and flattened out. BANROCK raced along the outside, had no rally. PIAZZA DI SPAGNA three to four wide on the turn, was under a drive entering the stretch and tired. UNCLE T SEVEN fanned five wide into the stretch, failed to menace.
