GENERAL QUARTERS was in a good stalking position while four wide, rallied on the second turn and loomed boldly, could not get by the winner late but gave way grudgingly. DEMARCATION was unhurried early while four and five wide, improved position in the stretch but was no threat. WORKIN FOR HOPS was well placed on the inside, ran evenly with no rally. BARYSHNIKOV was unhurried early while seven wide and lost ground, had nor ally. STRIKE IMPACT dueled for the lead and set the pace on the inside, faltered and faded. HAVELOCK pressed the pace with good early speed while five wide, gave way and dropped back. SHEDIK (FR) bobbed at the start and then failed to menace.
