FURTHEST LAND within striking distance four wide while in hand, moved up slowly in that path on the second turn, responded when asked for his best once in the stretch and wore down DUBIOUS MISS in the closing strides. DUBIOUS MISS reserved while close up and three wide, relaxed tracking the leaders the opening six furlongs, moved up in the three path approaching the stretch, challenged when ready entering the stretch, drew clear with a furlong to go but missed. SLIGOVITZ outrun early while off the inside, angled out to be four wide with three furlongs to go when commencing his rally but lodged only a mild late bid. TIMELESS FASHION vied for the lead while saving ground and in hand, responded when the runner up challenged entering the stretch, held on well to the final furlong and weakened. WICKED STYLE within striking distance along the inside, stayed near the rail on the second turn, angled out inside the final furlong and tired. HOLD ME BACK unhurried for a half while outrun, angled out five wide late on the second turn and could not threaten. YOUR ROUND within striking distance off the rail, moved out four wide approaching the stretch and gave way. JAZZ IN THE PARK was outrun. GODOLPHIN GRAY alternated for the lead off the inside, held on well for six furlongs and stopped.
