Non-winners of a Grade I race since June 25, 2010, allowed 3 lbs.; Non-winners of a Grade I race or Two Grade II races since December 25, 2009, 5 lbs. SWITCH stalked the pace inside, moved up along the rail with a bid on the turn, took the lead approaching the quarter pole, kicked clear in the stretch and proved best under a tap of the whip and steady handling. MALIBU PIER steadied between foes just after the start, settled a bit off the rail then inside on the turn, went around a rival nearing the stretch and was clearly second best. SHOTGUN GULCH bumped between horses in the early strides, settled outside a rival on the backstretch and again on the turn, found the rail in the stretch and gained the show late. ALWAYS A PRINCESS bumped early, stalked between horses then off the rail on the turn, came three deep into the stretch and was edged late for third. IT TIZ chased a bit off the rail, came out leaving the turn and three deep into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. CHAMPAGNE D'ORO bumped in the opening strides, stalked the pace three deep then outside into and on the turn, came four wide into the stretch and did not rally. TORNADO BETTY sped to the early lead, set the pace a bit off the rail, was alongside the winner leaving the turn, weakened in the stretch and had the rider lose the whip a sixteenth out. BONNIE BLUE FLAG stalked outside then alongside a rival, continued between foes leaving the backstretch, was in a bit tight into the turn, dropped back on the bend, angled in nearing the stretch and weakened. HARD WAY TEN settled off the rail, angled in approaching the turn and did not rally. PATRIOTIC VIVA stalked the pace a bit off the rail then outside a rival, steadied in tight nearing the stretch and weakened.
