Closed with 15. \$1,500 to enter, \$3,000 additional to start, with \$300,000 guaranteed, of which \$180,000 to first, \$60,000 to second, \$36,000 to third, \$18,000 to fourth and \$6,000 to fifth. 123 lbs. Non-winners of a Grade I race since June 30, 2012, allowed 3 lbs.; Non-winners of a Grade I race or Two Grade II races since December 25, 2011, 5 lbs. A trophy will be presented to the owner of the winner. (Cloudy 61)

RENEESGOTZIP had speed outside a rival then inched away briefly and angled in, dueled inside, came a bit off the fence into the stretch, fought back inside through the drive, brushed with MY MISS AURELIA in midstretch and again in deep stretch and continued gamely to the wire. MY MISS AURELIA dueled three deep then outside the runner-up into the stretch, brushed with that one in midstretch and again late and went on willingly between foes late. CANDREA chased a bit off the rail on the backstretch and turn, found the inside in the stretch, came off the rail in deep stretch and continued willingly but was outfinished. NECHEZ DAWN had speed inside then dueled between horses, fell back a bit off the rail into the stretch and weakened. CREDITCARDROULETTE dropped back just off the inside in the early going, settled a bit off the rail to the stretch and did not rally. MAMMA KIMBO stalked inside then off the rail on the backstretch and turn, came four wide into the stretch and weakened. RENEESGOTZIP wore calks.
