MEDEA (IRE) saved ground under patient handling, swung outside when set down in upper stretch, closed determinedly and was along in time. PARTY STARTER, clear early, set the pace along the rail, responded to urging in the drive and gave way grudgingly. SCAMPERING, wide the first turn, advanced three deep on the far turn to reach a striking position then flattened out between horses. MISTY IN MALIBU, three deep the first turn, chased the pace two wide to mid stretch then lacked the needed late response. FASNACLOICH, three deep the far turn, was floated out by the winner in upper stretch and closed the gap late. BOHEMIAN DANCE (IRE) saved ground, was forwardly placed in the stretch and lacked room near the sixteenth pole. LADY OF GOLD lacked speed, saved ground on the turns and was not a factor. LONESOME TOWN saved ground the far turn, swung wide in upper stretch and failed to rally. ANTONIA AUTUMN, steadied in traffic entering the first turn, was not a factor. ZUCCHINI FLOWER, very wide the first turn, was not a factor. MOMENT IN DIXIE raced between horses and failed to rally. CHAT, wide the first turn, was outrun. JOY, wide both turns, was outrun. FERRY MUSIC, checked in tight quarters entering the first turn, was outrun.
