1 1/4 MILES. (1.463) (Off The Turf) STAKES. Purse \$150,000 LAKE GEORGE S. (GRADE III) INNER TURF FOR FILLIES THREE YEARS OLD. No nomination fee. \$1,500 to pass the entry box. All starters will receive a \$1,000 rebate. The purse to be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally among remaining finishers. Any filly that competes in both the Lake George and the Lake Placid will have their entry fee waived for the Lake Placid. 122 lbs. TURF: Non-winners of a Graded Sweepstake on the turf in 2009 allowed 2 lbs.; A sweepstake on the turf, 4 lbs.; two races on the turf, 6 lbs. DIRT: Non-winners of a sweepstake at a mile or over on the dirt allowed 2 lbs.; two races at a mile or over on the dirt, 4 lbs.; two races, 6 lbs. (Maiden, claiming, starter or restricted allowance races not considered for turf and dirt). A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. The New York Racing Association reserves the right to transfer this race to the main track. In the event that this race is taken off the turf, it may be subject to downgrading up on review by the Graded Stakes Committee. Closed Saturday, July 18, 2009 with 42 Nominations. (Cloudy 70)

BE FAIR sprinted clear in the early stages, set the pace well off the rail on the backstretch, raced in hand while clear on the far turn, dug in when challenged at the quarter pole, fought back to reclaim a clear advantage in upper stretch then drew away under intermittent right hand encouragement. MARY'S FOLLIES tracked the winner while four wide for five furlongs, edged a bit closer on the turn, put a head in front at the quarter pole, was unable to stay with MARY'S FOLLIES in upper stretch and continued on willingly to clear best the others. THE BEST DAY EVER angled in to avoid being caught wide on the first turn, but failed to threaten while trailing most of the trip. CONSEQUENCE stalked three wide for a half, raced within striking distance to the far turn, dropped back in upper stretch and steadily tired thereafter.
