1 $\frac{1}{4}$ MILES. (1.42) STAKES. Purse \$100,000 *LOUISIANA CHAMPIONS DAY LADIES S. FOR FILLIES AND MARES THREE YEARS OLD AND UPWARD, ACCREDITED LOUISIANA BRED*. Early bird nominations closed September 15, 2011 at \$150. Final closing on November 1, 2011 at \$500. \$400 to pass the entry box and \$400 additional to start. \$100,000 Guaranteed of which \$60,000 to the winner, \$20,000 to second, \$11,000 to third, \$6,000 to fourth, \$3,000 to fifth. Weight: Three Year Olds - 121 lbs. Older - 124 lbs. Non-winners of a graded sweepstakes at a mile or over in 2011 allowed 2 lbs. \$36,000 twice at a mile or over in 2011 allowed 4 lbs. Non-winners of three races at a mile or over in 2011 other than maiden, claiming or starter allowed 6 lbs. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. Preference to horses that have accumulated the highest total earnings in 2011. This Stake will be limited to 12 starters should race not be split. Different owners have equal draw according to money earned. Second choice high earners of a same owner entry receive no consideration over a single entry. Failure to draw into the race will cancel all fees. The owner of the winner to receive a trophy. Closed Tuesday, November 1, 2011, with 26 nominations. (Cloudy 54)

HARLIE'S DREAMS raced four then three wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, ranged up while three to four wide on the far turn, came in while making a bid inside the quarter-pole, gained a short lead, was immediately challenged by LAWYER TIFFANY, drifted out under left hand urging passing the furlong marker, was switched to a right-handed whip, battled gamely late and just held under strong urging. LAWYER TIFFANY raced three wide early on the first turn, dropped to the inside late on that turn, was rated along the rail, waited behind the leader on the far turn, shifted out inside the quarter-pole, drifted out while making a bid in upper stretch, was straightened some by the rider, drifted out badly while battling with the winner in the final furlong and just missed. CAT'S PRODUCTION tracked the pace, chased two to three wide on the far turn and weakened while able to get the show. RILEYS MONARCH saved ground on the first turn, was urged along on the backstretch, came under strong urging while inside on the far turn and failed to menace while gaining some ground. SKIPPING TOWN set the pace through moderate fractions, lost the lead inside the quarter-pole and gave way. VICKIES IN TOWN was reserved off the pace, raced three wide while ridden along on the far turn, came four wide into the stretch and failed to rally. TOUGH ISSIE broke a bit slow, lingered well back in the field, advanced four wide on the far turn, came five wide into the stretch and failed to threaten.
