6 FURLONGS. (1.08) STAKES. Purse \$100,000 LOUISIANA CHAMPIONS DAY LASSIE S. FOR TWO YEAR OLD FILLIES, ACCREDITED LOUISIANA BRED. Early bird nominations closed September 15, 2011 at \$150. Final closing on November 1, 2011 at \$500. \$400 to pass the entry box and \$400 additional to start. \$100,000 Guaranteed of which \$60,000 to the winner; \$20,000 to second; \$11,000 to third; \$6,000 to fourth; \$3,000 to fifth. Weight: 122 lbs. Maidens allowed 5 lbs. (Winners Preferred) Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. Preference to horses that have accumulated the highest total earnings. This Stake will be limited to 14 starters should race not be split. Different owners have equal draw according to money earned. Second choice high earners of a same owner entry receive no consideration over a single entry. Failure to draw into the race will cancel all fees. The owner of the winner to receive a trophy. Closed Tuesday, November 1, 2011, with 70 nominations. (Cloudy 54)

IZZIE'S GOLD broke out at the start, showed good speed, crossed in front of the field, moved to a clear lead, controlled the tempo while inside on the turn, drew off without any encouragement in upper stretch, was asked some near the sixteenth-pole and proved much the best while ridden out. CARMEN'S MYSTERY showed good speed towards the inside, steadied outside the half-mile pole, saved ground on the turn, angled out in upper stretch and finished willingly for the place. SUNDAY'S CHILD was urged along towards the front, raced two then three wide on the turn, shifted four wide at the top of the stretch and weakened while able to get the show. MISTY MICHELLE brushed with rivals at the start, raced between horses while towards the rear, went two then three wide on the turn, shifted six wide at the top of the stretch and improved position. KAKI'S STORM was carried out at the start, chased the pace on the outside, raced three then two wide on the turn and tired. CAPE TOWN BRIDE brushed with a rival at the start, dropped to the rear of the field while urged along, went three then four wide on the turn, angled out inside the quarter-pole and failed to threaten. EFFIE raced between rivals, brushed with TENSAS SALT near the half-mile pole, was ridden along while off the rail on the turn, swung four wide into the stretch and failed to rally. BLEU DARLING broke a bit slow, moved up on the outside of the field, chased four then three wide on the turn and had nothing left. SHEZACRAZYLLIS brushed with a rival at the start, settled on the inside, lost position near the half-mile pole, saved ground on the turn and failed to respond. COTEAU KITTEN showed good early speed, dropped back outside the half-mile pole, raced inside on the turn and tired. TENSAS SALT brushed with EFFIE near the half-mile pole, raced three wide on the turn, came five wide into the stretch and faltered.
