ALL STAR HEART chased inside then a bit off the rail, fell back some on the second turn, came out a bit wide into the stretch, gained the lead four wide past midstretch and won clear under some left handed urging. CITY TO CITY saved ground chasing the pace, came out into the stretch, bid between foes in midstretch and continued toward the inside for the place. SARAH'S SECRET pulled a bit and stalked the leader off the rail, bid between foes into the second turn, continued off the inside leaving that turn, bid again alongside ASH ZEE to take the lead into the stretch, battled between horses in midstretch and held third. MALIBU PIER chased outside a rival then just off the rail, bid three deep into the second turn, fell back some off the rail, came three wide into the stretch, re-bid between horses in midstretch and was outfinished. ASH ZEE sped to the early lead, set the pace inside, responded when challenged into the second turn, inched away again leaving that turn, battled along the rail past midstretch, then weakened.
