6 FURLONGS. (1.08) STAKES. Purse \$100,000 LOUISIANA CHAMPIONS DAY SPRINT S. FOR THREE YEAR OLDS AND UPWARD, ACCREDITED LOUISIANA BRED. Early bird nominations closed September 15, 2011 at \$150. Final closing on November 1, 2011 at \$500. \$400 to pass the entry box and \$400 additional to start. \$100,000 Guaranteed of which \$60,000 to the winner, \$20,000 to second, \$11,000 to third, \$6,000 to fourth, \$3,000 to fifth. Weight: Three Year Olds - 122 lbs. Older- 124 lbs. Non-winners of a graded sweepstakes in 2011 allowed 2 lbs. Non-winners of \$36,000 twice in 2011 allowed 4 lbs. Non- winners of three races other than maiden, claiming or starter in 2011 allowed 6 lbs. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. Preference to horses that have accumulated the highest total earnings in 2011. This Stake will be limited to 14 starters should race not be split. Different owners have equal draw according to money earned. Second choice high earners of a same owner entry receive no consideration over a single entry. Failure to draw into the race will cancel all fees . The owner of the winner to receive a trophy. Closed Tuesday, November 1, 2011, with 23 nominations. (Cloudy 54)

AMANECER DE ORO chased the pace, raced off the rail on the turn, was asked for his best in upper stretch, closed determinedly under strong hand urging and prevailed. BOLD RECRUIT showed good natural speed, accelerated to a clear lead, dictated terms through the turn, was asked for more at the top of the stretch, led into the final sixteenth but was overtaken. SOUTHERN DUDE moved up then was taken in hand, came under urging while three wide on the turn, was put to a drive in upper stretch and lacked the needed kick while able to get the show. MY STAR RUNNER was urged along on the outside, raced five then four wide on the turn and lacked the needed response. CHIEF JAY was ridden along near the back, raced off the rail on the turn, moved out in upper stretch and improved position. SU CASA G CASA raced towards the front of the field while on the inside, saved ground on the turn and weakened. UNITAS bumped with a rival at the start, was taken in hand outside the half-mile pole, dropped in shortly thereafter, raced towards the inside on the turn and failed to rally. PANTARA PHANTOM bumped with a rival at the start then dropped back, raced three wide on the turn and failed to threaten. OLLIE BABY was forwardly placed on the outside, dropped back near the half-mile pole, went four to five wide on the turn and came up empty.
