QUICK CASABLANCA (CHI) broke slowly, came off the rail and chased outside a rival, angled out on the second turn and four wide into the stretch and rallied under urging to get up between foes late. FIRE WITH FIRE had speed between horses then set the pace inside, shook off a bid on the backstretch, came a bit off the rail in the stretch and held on gamely but was edged late. ROOKIE SENSATION settled inside then a bit off the rail, came out some into the stretch, waited behind rivals in midstretch, was taken out for room and finished willingly three deep on the line. LAKERVILLE pulled under a hold early, stalked inside, continued along the rail on the second turn and in the stretch and went on well to the end but was outfinished. SPRING UP tugged some and stalked outside a rival, went three deep on the second turn and into the stretch, was between foes past midstretch and also was outfinished late. JOELITO stalked inside then came off the rail and bid alongside the pacesetter on the first turn, stalked just off the rail on the backstretch and second turn, was between foes in midstretch and weakened some late.
