STRIKE A DEAL stalked the pace, was in hand awaiting room near the three eighths pole, closed outside RUTLEDGE CAT and drove clear. RUTLEDGE CAT stalked the pace, circled the far turn, drifted in when clear in midstretch and weakened late. BRAINY BENNY (IRE) lacked speed, raced wide and rallied. SOLVENT, bumped leaving the starting gate, swung very wide entering the stretch and rallied. ON MY DIME bore in leaving the starting gate, raced between horses in the stretch and weakened. GAMMY'S A WINNER set the pace along the rail and weakened. C R'S DEPUTY bore in leaving the starting gate, raced very wide around the far turn and was no factor. WING WALKER chased the pace three wide and gave way. ROMP (ARG), four wide the first turn, gave way. T HARRY was not a factor. MOUDEZ (IRE) was outrun. TRULY COURAGEOUS pressed the pace two wide and fell back. MAY EIGHTEENTH raced inside horses and fell back. ZENFULLY, pinched back leaving the starting gate, was outrun.
