CHARLIE'S MOMENT angled in and dueled inside, inched away into the turn, responded when a rival loomed in midstretch and won clear under some urging and a strong hand ride. BET ON VICTOR chased outside, went three deep on the turn and into the stretch and gained the place late. CANONIZE stalked the pace inside, came out a bit into the stretch, loomed behind the winner in midstretch, could not match that one and lost second late. POSITION A prompted the pace four wide then three deep, stalked three wide on the turn and into the stretch and could not offer the necessary late response. QUINDICI MAN broke a bit slowly, saved ground chasing the pace, remained inside in the stretch and lacked the needed rally. CARBONITE prompted the pace between horses then stalked off the rail into the turn, came out in the stretch and weakened. BACKBACKBACKGONE dueled between rivals then stalked the leader on the turn, dropped back into the stretch and weakened. ALL SAINT pulled a bit early, settled outside a rival then between foes leaving the backstretch, dropped back into and on the turn and had little left for the stretch.
