SMILING TIGER sped to the early lead outside, angled in and set the pace a bit off the rail or inside, responded when challenged into the turn, inched away just off the fence leaving the turn, drifted in a bit past midstretch and held on gamely under urging. CONCORD POINT angled in and stalked outside a rival, bid alongside the winner into the turn, tracked that one just off the fence leaving the turn and outside a foe in midstretch and continued willingly to the wire. DOMONATION settled outside, went three deep on the turn and into the stretch and picked up the show. MACIAS had good early speed and stalked inside, saved ground on the turn and into the stretch, came out some for room in midstretch and weakened. SKIPSHOT chased between horses then outside a rival, continued a bit off the fence on the turn, came out into the stretch and could not offer the necessary late response. BIG MAN HAS A SIGN chased outside then alongside a rival on the backstretch and turn, went around a foe into the stretch and did not rally. DIXIE TROUPER a bit slow into stride, settled inside, split horses into the turn, continued along the rail on the turn and into the stretch and was not a threat. MR TOKYO was in a good position chasing the pace inside, dropped back leaving the backstretch, remained inside to the stretch and lacked a further response. HAWAIIAN SPRINGS broke alertly then dropped back outside or off the rail, angled in some on the backstretch, came out in the stretch and was always outrun.
