1 1/4 MILES. (1.473) STAKES. Purse \$150,000 LOUISIANA CHAMPIONS DAY CLASSIC S. FOR THREE YEAR OLDS AND UPWARD, ACCREDITED LOUISIANA BRED. Early bird nominations closed September 15, 2013 at \$150. Final closing on November 1, 2013 at \$500. \$700 to pass the entry box and \$700 additional to start. \$150,000 Guaranteed of which \$90,000 to the winner, \$30,000 to second, \$16,500 to third, \$9,000 to fourth, \$4,500 to fifth. Weight: Three Year Olds - 121 lbs. Older - 124 lbs. Non-winners of \$60,000 at a mile or over in 2013 allowed 2 lbs. \$36,000 twice at a mile or over in 2013 allowed 4 lb s. Non-winners of three races at a mile or over other than maiden, claiming or starter in 2013 allowed 6 lbs. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. Preference to horses that have accumulated the highest total earnings in 2013. This Stake will be limited to 14 starters. Failure to draw into the race will cancel all fees. The owner of the winner to receive a trophy. Closed Friday, November 1, 2013, with 14 nominations. (Clouy 63)

Bay Gelding, (Apr), by Brahms - X Strawndair by Malagra. Trainer Faucheux Ron. Bred by Brittlyn, Inc.(LA).

SUNBEAN went three wide on the first turn, was rated kindly on the outside, raced three wide on the far turn, was asked near the five-sixteenths pole, took the lead in upper stretch, held about a length advantage while under a right-handed whip into the final furlong, came out some when switched to a left-handed whip outside the sixteenth-pole, went back to a right-handed whip and narrowly prevailed under strong urging. STRING KING tracked the pace while off the inside, turned up the pressure on the far turn, was asked at the quarter-pole, battled gamely in the stretch and just missed while under a vigorous right-handed whip. SKIP THE PINOT was well rated while setting the pace on the inside, responded well when asked at the quarter-pole, battled determinedly with the top two into the final sixteenth and was outfinished late while well clear for the show. ARKANSAS MARTINI settled on the inside, was ridden along on the far turn, came off the rail approaching the quarter-pole and tired. GET IN DA HOUSE went three wide on the first turn, settled towards the rear, was urged along while four wide on the far turn, moved a bit closer while five wide into the stretch but came up empty. ONE KING'S MAN saved ground on the first turn, settled off the pace, was urged along while two then three wide on the far turn and failed to respond. LEE'S SPIRIT settled at the rear, saved ground on the turns and showed little. POPULIST POLITICS raced off the rail on the first turn, settled outside on the backstretch, advanced four wide on the far turn, chased into the stretch and faltered.
