Final closing on November 1, 2013 at \$500. \$400 to pass the entry box and \$400 additional to start. \$100,000 Guaranteed of which \$60,000 to the winner, \$20,000 to second, \$11,000 to third, \$6,000 to fourth, \$3,000 to fifth. Weight: Three Year Olds - 122 lbs. Older- 124 lbs. Non-winners of a graded sweepstakes in 2013 allowed 2 lbs. Non-winners of \$36,000 twice in 2013 allowed 4 lbs. Non-w innerers of three races other than maiden, claiming or starter in 2013 allowed 6 lbs. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. Preference to horses that have accumulated the highest total earnings in 2013. This Stake will be limited to 14 starters. Failure to draw into the race will cancel all fees. The owner of the winner to receive a trophy. Closed Friday, November 1, 2013, with 23 nominations. (Cloudy 63)

Bay Gelding, (Mar), by Fusaichi Pegasus - Sparkles of Luck by Mr. Sparkles. Trainer Broberg Karl. Bred by Rowell Enterprises, Inc. (LA).

HEITAI bumped with a rival at the start, quickly sped clear, dictated terms through the turn, responded well when set down in upper stretch and drew off under strong urging. SOUTHERN DUDE tracked the pace on the outside, chased two to three wide on the turn, pursued the winner under a drive in upper stretch and proved no match while able to hold the place. HERO FORCE was ridden along while off the pace, raced inside on the turn, shifted three wide at the quarter-pole, advanced past a few rivals into the final furlong and earned the show while drifting out. JOYCE'S REBEL came out and brushed a rival just after the start, settled behind a wall of horses, was asked while off the rail on the turn, angled out in upper stretch and improved position. PALMY BAY was urged along while off the pace, raced inside on the turn and failed to rally. LOUISIANA GLORY bumped with a rival at the start, chased the pace, raced inside on the turn, came off the rail at the quarter-pole and tired. PRODUCTIVE ENVOY was in tight early, settled towards the rear, raced inside early on the turn, shifted three wide late on the bend and failed to threaten. FOREIGN PRODUCTION bumped with rivals at the start, jostled with an opponent early, was urged along towards the front, went three wide on the turn, bumped solidly with TEXAS FIRE at the quarter-pole and came up empty. UNITAS bumped with a rival at the start, jostled with that same opponent early, raced well back in the field, went three then four wide on the turn and was no factor. AMANECER DE ORO bumped with a rival at the start, was urged along near the middle of the field, raced off the rail on the turn and failed to respond. THE LOUISIANA KID was ridden along while off the pace, went three then four wide on the turn, came five wide into the stretch and also failed to respond. TEXAS FIRE was urged along on the outside, went four wide on the turn, bumped with FOREIGN PRODUCTION at the quarter-pole and faded.
