About 1 1/8 MILES. (Turf) (1.42) STAKES. Purse \$100,000 LOUISIANA CHAMPIONS DAY TURF S. FOR THREE YEAR OLDS AND UPWARD, ACCREDITED LOUISIANA BRED. Early bird nominations closed September 15, 2013 at \$150. Final closing on November 1, 2013 at \$500. \$400 to pass the entry box and \$400 additional to start. \$100,000 Guaranteed of which \$60,000 to the winner, \$20,000 to second, \$11,000 to third, \$6,000 to fourth, \$3,000 to fifth. Weight: Three Year Olds-121 lbs. Older -124 lbs. Non-winners of \$36,000 twice at a mile or over on the turf in 2013 allowed 2 lbs. Non-winners of a sweepstakes at a mile or over on the turf in 2013 allowed 4 lbs. Non-winners of three races at a mile or over on the turf other than maiden, claiming or starter in 2013 allowed 6 lbs. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. Preference to horses that have accumulated the highest earnings on the turf in 2013. This stake will be limited to 14 starters. Failure to draw into the race will cancel all fees. The owner of the winner to receive a trophy. Closed Friday, November 1, 2013, with 22 nominations. (If deemed inadvisable by management to run this race over the turf course, it will be run on the main track at One Mile and One Sixteenth.) (Rail at 25 feet). (Cloudy 68)

HUD'S REBELLION raced off the rail on the first turn, was well placed behind the leading duo, ranged up while three wide on the far turn, made a bid passing the five-sixteenths, edged clear under a left-handed whip in upper stretch, switched to a right-handed whip late and proved best under good handling. SADIE'S SOLDIER was reserved on the inside, moved closer with five furlongs to run, came off the inside on the far turn, shifted three wide into the stretch, chased the winner under a strong hand ride, was put to a right-handed whip near the furlong marker, drifted out when switched to a left-handed whip at the sixteenth-pole, went back to a right-handed whip and narrowly earned the place. SWEET BABY GAINES contested the pace on the inside, came under a drive in upper stretch, fought on well in the final furlong but was outfinished then just missed the place. REQUEST A PUCK went three wide on the first turn, contested the pace on the outside, vied off the rail on the far turn, dropped back under a drive in upper stretch and weakened. PLANO ZIP was asked from the start but dropped well behind while on the inside, saved ground while ridden along on the far turn and failed to respond. OLD PAL OF MINE went two to three wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, was ridden along while two to three wide on the far turn and faltered. (Rail at 25 Feet)
