FOR THREE YEAR OLDS AND UPWARD WHICH HAVE NOT WON A GRADED SWEEPSTAKES IN 2014.* By subscription of \$100 each which should accompany the nomination; \$500 to pass the entry box and an additional \$500 to start. For horses not originally nominated, a supplemental nomination payment of \$1,000 along with the entry and starting fees may be made at any time prior to the closing of entries. The purse to be divided 60% to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally amongst the remaining finishers. Weights, three year olds, 120 lbs. Older, 124 lbs. Non-winners of a Sweepstake in 2014 allowed 2 lbs.; of two races other than maiden, claiming or starter in 2014, 4 lbs.; of one such race in 2014, 6 lbs. GOLDEN TICKET raced from off the inside throughout, sat detached from the others during the opening stages, picked up the pace after leaving the half mile pole, got angled outward into the five path past from the five-sixteenths pole, closed in readily after getting straightened away, grabbed away the lead with a few strides to spare before arriving at the finish line. PANTS ON FIRE leaned briefly on INTEGRITY at the start, patiently stalked that rival to the quarter pole, challenged for command after arriving at that station, held on willingly to the end en route to garnering the place. INTEGRITY rubbed shoulders with PANTS ON FIRE as the field was sent off and running, gained control, showed the way being rated along the inside, got put to a stern test approaching the quarter pole, yielded reluctantly in the final stages. STORMIN MONARCHO bobbed at the start, underwent a three wide pursuit on the turn, commenced the stretch one path wider, lacked the needed late closing punch. ALPHA fought the bit during the initial stages, was angled off the inside route in upper stretch, had no response.
