Purse \$400,000 *LONE STAR PARK H.(GRADE III) (PLUS UP TO \$13,500 Open ATB) FOR THREE YEAR OLDS AND UPWARD.* No nomination fee. \$3,000 to pass the entry box and an additional \$3,000 to start with \$400,000 guaranteed of which \$240,000 to the owner of the winner, \$80,000 to second \$44,000 to third, \$24,000 to fourth and \$12,000 to fifth. Weights; Sunday, May 21, 2006. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. High weights preferred. The field will be limited to fourteen starters. Horses not drawing a starting positi on in the gate will receive a refund of the entry fee. A suitable award will be presented to the winning owner. Nominations closed Wednesday, May 17, 2006 with 31 nominations.

MAGNUM (ARG) shifted out leaving the first turn, settled behind the leading group, ranged up while four wide on the far turn, took the lead at the top of the stretch and inched clear under good handling. TEXCESS contested the pace on the inside, inched clear passing the quarter-pole, lost the lead at the top of the stretch and was outfinished while well clear for the place. REAL DANDY was reserved near the back of the field while saving ground, moved around a rival midway through the far turn and earned the show while no match for the top two. COSMONAUT was restless in the gate, raced three wide on the first turn, settled towards the rear of the field, was roused while three wide on the far turn, shifted five wide into the stretch and failed to rally. NAKAYAMA KUN brushed with a rival after the start, raced four wide on the first turn, was unhurried at the back of the field, swung six wide into the stretch and failed to threaten. DOMINGUIN (PER) raced four then three wide on the first turn, tracked the leaders down the backstretch, came up empty while near the rail on the far turn and faded. STOCKHOLDER brushed with a rival after the start, raced five then four wide on the first turn, contested the pace on the outside, vied three wide on the far turn and also faded. PREACHINATTHEBAR was restless in the gate, raced four wide on the first turn, was urged along on the backstretch, went three wide on the far turn, came five wide into the stretch and failed to respond. WATCHEM SMOKEY bumped with a rival at the start, contested the pace between rivals, dropped out near the quarter-pole and stopped. WISHINGITWAS bumped with a rival at the start, raced three wide on the first turn, was urged along near the middle of the field and retreated after a half-mile.
