By subscription of \$250 each, which shall accompany the nomination, \$1,500 to enter, \$1,500 additional to start with \$225,000 guaranteed and an additional \$75,000 from the Breeders' Cup Fund for cup nominees only. ASSESSMENT raced off the leaders early, angled outside nearing the five-sixteenths marker, responded to steady urging, wore down ATTA BOY ROY in the final sixteenth and held off the closing AWESOME GEM to prevail. AWESOME GEM lacked early speed, raced far wide through the second turn and finished with good energy. TEIDE was void of early speed, bumped with TRUMPET PLAYER JAY nearing the five-sixteenths pole, moved between foes late and finished with a solid late rally. WASSERMAN showed no early speed, raced far wide through the second turn and finished with a steady rally. ATTA BOY ROY went to the front soon after the start, opened a clear lead before going a quarter, saved ground while setting the pace and gave way through the final sixteenth. BANK EMBLEM was bumped at the start, raced off the leaders from the inside, moved up to offer a bid nearing the quarter, steadied nearing the sixteenth pole and lost chance for a better placing. AUTISM AWARENESS was bumped at the start, raced far wide through the second turn and finished evenly in the drive. GALLON was void of early speed, angled outside approaching the stretch and also finished evenly. SIERRA SUNSET chased the leaders from the outside and weakened after going six furlongs. KRUGER PARK was away alertly then raced off the leaders from the outside and gradually weakened. TRUMPET PLAYER JAY was bumped at the start, raced off the leaders from the inside, was bumped and steadied nearing the five-sixteenths pole and did not menace thereafter. CRAFTY POWER chased the leaders from the outside and weakened after going three-quarters.
