AWESOME GEM was carried wide through the first turn, raced off the pacesetters early, advanced from the outside through the second turn, reached NOOSA BEACH with a furlong to run and edged clear of that rival in the drive. NOOSA BEACH set a pressured pace from off the rail, responded when challenged into the lane, but could not match strides with the winner through the final furlong. POSSE POWER chased the leaders from the inside and gave way gradually in the drive. CREW LEADER raced just off the leaders from the outside throughout and lacked the needed closing response. WASSERMAN showed no early speed, raced far wide through the second turn and finished with some late run. J P JAMMER raced off the pacesetters throughout, moved outside through the second turn and failed to rally. WINNING MACHINE raced off the leaders from the outside and lacked the needed finishing response. ASSESSMENT raced off the leaders early, moved outside through the second turn and was not a factor. SLEW THE MAN pressed the pace from the outside and weakened after going three-quarters. HONOUR THE DEPUTY lacked early foot, saved ground throughout and failed to menace. SARATOGA BOOT showed no early speed, raced off the rail throughout and did not reach contention.
