RED ARROW (AUS) sped to the early lead, inched away on the backstretch, set the pace inside, drifted out then in a bit from the whip in the stretch but held on gamely. PAUL'S HOPE chased off the rail, came out leaving the turn and four wide into the stretch and finished well. DEHERE AGAIN (AUS) had good early speed then stalked outside a rival or a bit off the rail, was between horses in midstretch and continued willingly for the show. SIREN LURE between horses early, dropped back off the rail, angled in on the backstretch, swung out into the stretch and found his best stride late. GUNS ON THE TABLE broke out a bit and bobbled, went up inside to stalk the pace, continued along the rail on the turn and in the stretch and was outfinished for a minor award late. DOPPIO chased just off the inside, swung out into the stretch and could not offer the necessary late kick. NORTHERN SOLDIER angled in and stalked outside a rival, came three deep into the stretch and weakened. SOUL CITY SLEW allowed to settle off the rail, came out into the stretch and did not rally.
