DRILLING FOR OIL gained a forward position early while working his way in behind horses, moved to the front just before going six furlongs, went along under careful handling while dueling, drew clear in the upper stretch, edged in a bit tightening it up on RAMAZUTTI leaving the sixteenth pole, then held sway under urging. ALWAYS FIRST (GB), unhurried early and four wide, was steadied between horses at the seven-sixteenths pole, eased outside on the far turn, advanced seven wide into the lane and was going well at the end. RAMAZUTTI, unhurried early, moved near the inside, continued near the hedge when rallying into the lane, was in a bit tight leaving the sixteenth pole when the winner leaned in, steadied slightly, then lacked a final account. CLOUDY'S KNIGHT, unhurried early, moved up between horses on the far turn, continued prominently in closest attendance to the winner into the upper stretch but couldn't sustain the needed momentum. HOTSTUFANTHENSOME, never far back and between horses four or five wide most of the way, failed to muster a closing punch. I BELIEVE IN ME, in front inside after the start, allowed the advantage to ROYAL ASSAULT before going a quarter, remained a factor to the far turn and couldn't keep pace. MURCH, badly outrun for a half, made a sweeping run six wide around the far turn to loom menacingly but couldn't sustain his surge. LOUVE DES REVES (IRE), reserved in behind horses early and three wide, was steadied leaving the seven-sixteenths pole, maneuvered five wide for the drive but never fired. ROYAL ASSAULT gained a slight edge early while dueling and tired soon after going a mile. FRI GUY tired on the far turn. TRANSDUCTION GOLD, reluctant to load into the gate, raced forwardly between foes until approaching the final quarter and faded.
