1 1/8 MILES. (1.402) STAKES. Purse \$400,000 *LONE STAR PARK H. (GRADE III)* (PLUS UP TO \$15,750 Open ATB) FOR THREE YEAR OLDS AND UPWARD. No nomination fee. \$3,000 to pass the entry box and an additional \$3,000 to start with \$400,000 guaranteed of which \$240,000 to the owner of the winner, \$80,000 to second, \$44,000 to third, \$ 24,000 to fourth and \$12,000 to fifth. Weights: Saturday, May 16, 2009. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. High weights preferred. The field will be limited to fourteen starters. Horses not drawing a starting position in the gate will receive a refund of the entry fee. A suitable award will be presented to the winning owner. Nominations closed Thursday, May 14, 2009 with 29 nominations. (Clear 82)

IT'S A BIRD shifted three wide early on the first turn, settled just off the pace, engaged the leaders while three wide on the far turn, dueled gamely with JONESBORO in the stretch and narrowly prevailed under strong urging. JONESBORO tracked the pace, made a bid leaving the backstretch, dueled between rivals on the far turn, battled gamely with IT'S A BIRD in the stretch and was denied. SONG OF NAVARONE raced three wide on the first turn, settled towards the rear, went three wide early on the far turn, shifted five wide near the quarter-pole, rallied in upper stretch and closed well but missed. KING DAN set the pace through solid fractions, vied inside on the far turn, battled into the final furlong and gave way grudgingly. ENCAUSTIC was reserved off the pace, came under a ride on the far turn and failed to rally. MAGNUM (ARG) lingered towards the rear, was roused on the far turn and also failed to rally. Z FORTUNE raced three wide on the first turn, dropped in near the three-quarter pole, lagged at the rear of the field, came three wide into the stretch and failed to threaten. STUNGBYTHESTORM broke out slightly at the start, raced four wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, was urged along while four wide on the far turn and came up empty. UPSTREAM checked sharply near the seven-eighths pole, settled just off the pace on the inside, came up empty on the far turn and faded.
