1 1/4 MILES. (Turf) (1.443) STAKES. Purse \$350,000 *JOHN C. MABEE S. (GRADE I) FOR FILLIES AND MARES, THREE-YEAR-OLDS AND UPWARD.* By subscription of \$350 each, which shall accompany the nomination, \$3,500 additional to start, with \$350,000 Guaranteed, of which \$210,000 to first, \$70,000 to second, \$42,000 to third, \$21,000 to fourth and \$7,000 to fifth. The John C. Mabee Hcp. has been selected as one of the Breeders' Cup. filly and Mare Turf, subject to the payment of all pre-entry, entry and supplementary (if applicable) fees. To be eligible for the 2009 Breeders' Cup Championships to be held during the Oak Tree meeting at Santa Anita Park on November 6-7, 2009, all horse s must be pre-entered by noon (local time at the designated pre-entry locations) by October 26, 2009. All applicable fees shall accompany the pre-entry. Three-year-olds 119 lbs.; Older 123 lbs.; Non-winners of a Grade I at one mile or over in 2009 allow ed, 2 lbs.; of a Grade II at one mile or over in 2009 or a Grade I at one mile or over in 2008, 4 lbs. High weights preferred. A trophy will be presented to the owner of the winner. Nominations closed Thursday, August 6, 2009 with 19. (Clear 78)

MAGICAL FANTASY settled inside, came out on the second turn and four wide into the stretch and rallied under urging to gain the lead in deep stretch and proved best. GOTTA HAVE HER chased outside a rival, went three deep on the second turn and four wide into the stretch, rallied between horses in deep stretch and continued willingly to the wire. PATRICIA'S GEM sped to the early lead, angled in and set the pace inside, inched away leaving the second turn and into the stretch and held on well until the late stages then edged a rival for third. VISIT (GB) pulled a bit then was reserved off the pace outside a rival, came out on the second turn and five wide into the stretch and just missed the show. CHARMING LEGACY (IRE) pulled her way between horses to stalk the pace, continued three deep leaving the backstretch and on the second turn and into the stretch was between rivals in midstretch and was outfinished. MEYDAN PRINCESS (IRE) saved ground chasing then stalking the pace, continued inside on the second turn and in the stretch and could not summon the necessary response. BEL AIR SIZZLE angled in and settled off the pace inside, came out on the second turn and six wide into the stretch and made up some ground but was not a serious threat. TUSCAN EVENING (IRE) pulled early, stalked inside then between horses leaving the backstretch and on the second turn, came three deep into the stretch, drifted inward in the drive and weakened. BRIECAT three deep in the chute, stalked outside foes then off the rail, was between horses into the stretch and also weakened.
