MINERALOGIST was pinched back after breaking slowly, was outrun while four wide on the backstretch, closed a lengthy gap four wide on the turn, charged to the front nearing the furlong marker and held off the runner-up under steady urging. EMBRACE CHANGE dropped back before going a half mile, was outrun to the turn, drifted six wide at the quarter pole and closed late in the middle of the track to gain the place. STELLALUCE raced in good position for a half, split horses on the turn, gained in upper stretch and held late for third. RAFFIE'S ROSE pressed the pace three wide, lodged a mild bid on the turn and weakened in midstretch. SUGAR TRADE raced in midpack along the inside, swung four wide on the turn and lacked a late response. FUTURE FOOTNOTES ducked in at the start and was never close thereafter. VALUABLE LADY dueled in the two path, led to the turn and gave way. PORKCHOP SANDRA ducked in at the start, rushed up inside, dueled for five furlongs then gave way and was eased late.
