TWIRLING CANDY pulled his way along to stalk the pace outside on the backstretch and turn, came three deep into the stretch and rallied gamely under a strong hand ride and a late tap of the whip to get up nearing the wire. SMILING TIGER had speed outside then dueled alongside a rival, took a short lead into the stretch, inched away in midstretch and held on gamely but was edged late. CARACORTADO chased between horses then toward the inside, waited a bit off heels midway on the turn, came out leaving the turn and three deep into the stretch and finished well to edge a rival for the show. ALCINDOR had good early speed and dueled inside, came a bit off the rail into the stretch, drifted back to the fence in the drive and was outfinished late for third. NOBLE'S PROMISE close up stalking the pace a bit off the rail to the stretch, lacked the needed late kick. THISKYHASNOLIMIT chased between horses or outside a rival, split foes on the turn, came three deep into the stretch and could not offer the necessary response. SETSUKO a bit slow to begin, went up three deep then chased between horses, continued outside a rival on the turn and between foes into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. DON TITO chased between horses then inside into and on the turn and in the stretch and weakened. THOMAS BAINES four wide early, settled off the rail, went outside a rival into the stretch, came out some in the drive and was not a threat. PARIS VEGAS broke a bit slowly, saved ground throughout to no avail. OUR MINESWEEPER chased outside then three deep, dropped back on the turn and into the stretch, gave way and was eased in the final furlong.
