Closed with 24. \$1,500 to pass the entry box and \$3,000 additional to start, with \$300,000 guaranteed, of which \$180,000 to first, \$60,000 to second, \$36,000 to third, \$18,000 to fourth and \$6,000 to fifth. 123 lbs. Non-winners of a Grade I since June 25, 2011, allowed 3 lbs. Non-winners of a Grade I or Two Grade II races since December 25, 2010, allowed 5 lbs. Graded or Group winners have first preference regardless of weight. A trophy will be presented to the owner of the winner. (Clear 72)

THE FACTOR had good early speed and dueled three deep, inched away into the turn, continued off the inside into and through the stretch and proved best under urging. ROTHKO stalked a bit off the rail then inside, was in a bit tight and went around a rival into the turn, came out into the stretch, angled inward in midstretch, could not catch the winner but was second best. ASSOCIATE bumped at the start, settled off the rail then angled in toward the inside on the backstretch, went around a foe into the turn, split horses a sixteenth out and edged a rival for the show. LUCKARACK between horses early, stalked inside, steadied in tight into the turn, came off the rail, split foes into the stretch and was edged for third. RACING APTITUDE bumped lightly at the break, chased between horses on the backstretch and again on the turn, came three deep into the stretch and lacked the needed late kick. HOORAYFORHOLLYWOOD went up between horses to duel for the lead, brushed with a rival into the turn, stalked inside on the bend and weakened in the stretch. SMASH chased outside a rival then between horses, came out slightly off heels and split foes early on the turn, angled out again leaving the turn, entered the stretch four wide and could not offer the necessary late response. WINE POLICE broke in and bumped a rival, chased three deep, continued outside on the turn and into the stretch and did not rally. LIGHT UP THE SCORE stalked outside then three deep, continued outside on the turn and four wide into the stretch and weakened. CENTRALINTELLIGENCE had speed inside to duel for the lead, brushed with a rival, shied and took up sharply into the turn to drop back, came out into the stretch and was eased through the drive. The stewards conducted an inquiry into the run on the far turn before ruling CENTRALINTELLIGENCE was the cause of his own trouble.
