Bay Horse, (May), by Cacique (IRE) - Sound Asleep by Woodman. Trainer Chad C. Brown. Bred by Millsec Limited (GB).

SLUMBER (GB) behind cover two to three wide in mid pack, remained patiently handled until nearing the quarter pole, got angled four wide into upper stretch roused for the drive, offered up a good kick to arrive on the scene with a rush a furlong from home, overhauled the leader nearing the sixteenth marker and edged clear in the late stages. BIG BLUE KITTEN settled three wide near the rear rating kindly in hand, came under encouragement midway on the far turn, spun five wide into upper stretch, kicked home belatedly showing the best stride late and just got up for the place honors in the last jumps. LEGENDARY (GB) front rank three wide under rating, got set down at the head of the stretch, knocked heads with WAR DANCER taking a slight advantage a furlong from home, dug in fending off that rival when overhauled near the sixteenth pole then was outfinished in the last jumps for the place honors while just holding for the show. FINNEGANS WAKE allowed to settle along the hedge near the rear, got put to encouragement three furlongs from home, swung four wide into upper stretch, threaded his way through loose traffic inside the final sixteenth while offering late foot for the last major share. MAGIC ARTIST (IRE) three wide in hand in mid pack behind the cover of LEGENDARY, got pushed along with five-sixteenths remaining, angled out to be five wide at the head of the stretch, failed to quicken appreciably making no late headway on the front. WAR DANCER established the front shortly after the start and showed the way in hand just off the hedge in the two path while attended in close aim by LEGENDARY to the outside, marshaled the field the down backside, the rider's head on swivel seemingly intent on keeping TWILIGHT ECLIPSE bottled up in behind his cover, came under light coaxing into the far turn before being put to further urging with five-sixteenths to go, spun two to three wide at the quarter pole digging in under challenge, yielded narrow command a furlong from home before weakening in the late stages. TWILIGHT ECLIPSE just off the inside in aim of the front behind the cover of WAR DANCER, who at junctures down the backside seemed intent on keeping his rival there, moved to go inside into the far turn and remained in behind through that bend coming under coaxing at the five-sixteenths when gaining some clearance, swung three wide into upper stretch roused and offered no response. HYPER just off the pace tracking inside, came under encouragement with five-sixteenths to run, spun just off the inside for home, ran on along the hedge in striking distance to the furlong grounds before weakening late on. JACK MILTON four to five wide in pursuit from mid pack, got pushed along midway on the turn, angled out seven wide at the head of the stretch and weakened. BIZ THE NURSE (IRE) three wide in reserve behind cover, came under a ride three furlongs from home, shifted five wide into upper stretch and made no impact. GENERAL A ROD brushed the near side stall at the start, raced four wide in aim of the front until tucked to the three path into the far turn under coaxing from the half mile pole, angled out six wide into upper stretch and tired.
