Chestnut Mare, (Mar), by Not For Love - She's Jane by Northern Idol. Trainer Sleeter G. Kevin. Bred by Kevin Sleeter(NJ). TALKIN ABOUT LOVE, patiently handled in last while off the rail, angled out four to five wide when advancing into the stretch, closed sharply under steady hand pressure, forged to command inside the sixteenth pole and kicked clear. BEAU'S TRIP set a rated pace towards the inside, took pressure into the far turn, drifted out a bit in the lane and gave way grudgingly. HEAVENLY MOON saved ground, moved closer nearing the half mile marker, chased the leader into the lane and continued willingly to the wire. AMIE'S LEGEND, within range three wide, advanced four wide between rivals near mid stretch, steadied when in close near the sixteenth pole and continued with interest. ZIGGLY rated close up between rivals, steadied leaving the eighth pole then avoided LITTLE HARBOR in deep stretch. LITTLE HARBOR prompted the pace two wide, battled three wide past the eighth pole then broke down in the final yards. There was a stewards' inquiry into the stretch run and also an objection by the rider of AMIE'S LEGEND against the winner for alleged interference in the stretch. No action was taken.
