BEN'S BOOTS was angled off the rail nearing the turn, lodged a three wide bid under rating near the three eighths pole, dueled mid turn, opened up a clear advantage leaving the three sixteenths marker, finished gamely but just could not contain the winner. JÍM'S PROSPECT drifted in at the break and bumped with FAVORED LADY, circled five wide into the stretch and closed well. FOR ROYALTY had speed from the gate, eased back off the pace nearing the half mile pole, lodged a bid between rivals near the three furlong marker, dueled mid turn, continued to battle inside the leader into the stretch then faded in the final furlong.
