TOBOGGAN SLIDE advanced three wide leaving the backstretch, secured command on the turn, was prompted on the outside by PETECAROL entering the stretch, was set down in midstretch and drew away while kept to his business. PETECAROL, wide leaving the backstretch, moved up on the turn to press TOBOGGAN SLIDE, was no match for that one in the drive, drifted out then in near the sixteenth pole and held the place. CACTUS CHARLIE, lightly steadied in close quarters along the rail near the five eighths pole, raced off the rail on the turn, swung to the four path in upper stretch and passed tired horses. LOVE WHO drifted in leaving the starting gate, was a forward factor two wide and weakened in the drive. NOT MY PROBLEM, never a factor, was three wide in upper stretch. RUTLEDGE STAR, wide leaving the turn, was outrun. HEAVENSTMURGATROID drifted out leaving the starting gate, saved ground around the turn and was outrun. EL PICHON was outrun. MORUMSCO, bumped on both sides leaving the starting gate, had speed along the rail and stopped.
