(GRADE II) FOR FOUR YEAR OLDS AND UPWARD.** By subscription of \$400 by Saturday, March 16. \$2,000 to enter, \$2,000 additional to start. Supplemental nominations will be accepted by 12:00 Noon, Thursday, March 21 at a fee of \$12,000 which shall include entry and starting fees. \$400,000 Guaranteed of which 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 4% to fourth, 2% to fifth and 1% to starters sixth through ninth. Weights Thursday March 21. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. The Maximum field size for the Mervin H. Muniz Jr. Memorial Handicap will be determined by rail setting. High weights on the scale will be preferred. Failure to draw into the race will cancel all fees. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. Close d Saturday, March 16, 2013, with 21 nominations. (If deemed inadvisable by management to run this race over the turf course, it will be run on the main track at One Mile and One Eighthth.) (Cloudy 75)

AMIRA'S PRINCE (IRE) went two to three wide on the first turn, set the pace while well rated, was challenged while three wide on the far turn, came four wide into the stretch, inched clear under a drive and held gamely under strong urging. WILLCOX INN went three wide on the first turn, was rated just off the pace, chased three wide on the far turn, swung six wide into the stretch, pursued the winner into the final furlong and finished strongly but missed. STRING KING went four wide on the first turn, stalked the pace on the outside, made a bid while four wide on the far turn, came five wide into the stretch, chased into the final furlong and was outkicked while able to get the show. DOUBLES PARTNER raced off the rail on the first turn, settled off the pace, chased towards the inside on the far turn, came three wide into the stretch, held a good striking position into the final furlong but lacked the needed kick. OPTIMIZER went three wide on the first turn, settled off the pace, went two to three wide on the far turn, was asked near the five-sixteenths pole, dropped in at the quarter-pole and lacked the needed response. TWO MONTHS RENT was taken under a strong hold, went four wide on the first turn, was reserved towards the rear, came under urging while three to four wide on the far turn and also lacked the needed response. BIM BAM went five wide on the first turn, was reserved off the pace, raced five wide on the far turn, swung seven wide into the stretch and failed to rally. TIZ SARDONIC JOE brushed the outside of the gate at the start, went five wide on the first turn, was rated on the outside, raced six wide on the far turn, came eight wide into the stretch and tired. QUALITY CONTROL (BRZ) went four wide on the first turn, was reserved in the middle of the field, raced four wide while ridden along on the far turn, came five wide into the stretch and also failed to rally. FAST TRACK went four wide on the first turn, lagged at the rear, was urged along while two to three wide on the far turn, angled out in the final furlong and was no factor. (Rail at 0 Feet)
