Dark Bay or Brown Ridgeling, (Mair), by A.P. Indy - Serena's Cat by Storm Cat. Trainer Claude R. McGaughey III. Bred by Dell Ridge Farm, LLC (KY).

HONOR CODE was sent over into the two path shortly after the start, was already under some hand encouragement by midpoint on the backstretch, came to life commencing to get angled outward from the five-sixteenths pole, finished the maneuver being six wide, closed in with a rush to blow by PRIVATE ZONE and take charge with slightly under a furlong to go, drew well clear, crossing the wire being hand ridden. TONALIST was off a bit slowly, cautiously handled while in close proximity to a series of bumps, sat reserved from off the inside, left the three-eighths pole three wide, swung out towards the five path during the initial portion of the stretch, closed in on the front runner, shied out momentarily in the vicinity of the sixteenth pole, continued onward with good energy to procure the place. PRIVATE ZONE broke alertly, appeared eager during the setting of the first fraction, got steadied by the pilot, went about more professionally afterwards, took up residence in the two path, spun into the stretch and had the rider go to work, proved no match when confronted by the winner at the eighth pole, swerved out briefly with a sixteenth to go before weakening into the show slot. TAMARKUZ was knocked slightly sideways getting pushed inward by an errant BAYERN, drafted behind PRIVATE ZONE for the majority of the run around the bend, tipped into the three path and got set down issuing a challenge into the stretch, kept up the pursuit for an additional furlong before flattening out. WICKED STRONG part of the bumping incident at the break, was taken hold after getting squeezed back, raced the opening three quarters in the two path for a good portion of it, fanned wider and wider until seven wide with a furlong to go, lacked the needed late response. KOBES BACK in the two path, failed to pick up the pace when asked at the three-eighths pole. PANTS ON FIRE saved ground on the turn, failed to fire after being angled to the outside heading home. NOBLE MOON bobbed at the break, left the inside after being briefly placed along it, underwent a three wide pursuit on the turn, made no headway. BAY OF PLENTY chased the pace four wide on the turn, tired. BAYERN stumbled inward, bumping into the nearest opponent and affecting TGMEMARKUZ before it was all over, recovered and prompting PRIVATE ZONE from the three path for six furlongs, gave way.
