ZENYATTA settled off the rail then inside on the backstretch, was in a bit tight off heels into the second turn, came out and moved up outside on that turn, swung four wide into the stretch, made the lead outside a foe past the eighth pole, inched away and held under a moderate hand ride. LIFE IS SWEET allowed to settle a bit off the rail, angled in entering the second turn, came out into the stretch, went around the pacesetter nearing midstretch then bid inside but could not match the winner while holding second. ALLICANSAYIS WOW pulled a bit while stalking the pace just off the rail then inside, came out leaving the second turn, bid alongside a rival to gain the lead into the stretch, fought back in midstretch, could not quite match the top pair late but clearly bested the others. GAMBLER'S JUSTICE sped to the early lead, set a pressured pace inside, inched away briefly leaving the second turn, battled inside a rival into the stretch, then weakened. CHAMPAGNE EYES three deep early, prompted the pace outside a rival, fell back some leaving the second turn, came three wide into the stretch and also weakened. TASTE'S SIS pulled her way along to stalk the pace inside then a bit off the rail on the backstretch and second turn and had little left for the stretch.
