BRADESTER went three wide on the first turn, was rated on the outside, raced three wide on the far turn, was given his cue near the quarter-pole, made a bid in upper stretch, was given one crack of a left-handed whip coming to the furlong marker, quickly switched to a right-handed whip, battled with the runner-up into the final sixteenth and proved best under steady urging. GRAND CONTENDER was asked from the start, went to the front, set the pace on the inside while well rated, was asked at the quarter-pole, lost the lead while under a right-handed whip in upper stretch, switched to a left-handed whip near the furlong marker, battled with the winner into the final sixteenth, had the rider grandstand to attempt to get a disqualification late and was outfinished while able to get the place. FORDUBAI settled while off the inside, was ridden along on the far turn, moved out in upper stretch, chased into the final furlong and lacked the needed kick while able to get the show. GROUND TRANSPORT tracked the pace in the two path, was asked near the five-sixteenths pole, chased into the final furlong and weakened. AFFORD settled on the inside, was urged along on the far turn, came under the whip in upper stretch and gained some ground but failed to menace. PRAYER FOR RELIEF raced inside on the first turn, settled towards the front, was ridden along while three then four wide on the far turn, chased into upper stretch and tired. MICROMANAGE saved ground on the first turn, settled near the back, raced inside early on the far turn then came off the rail and failed to threaten. STEPHANOATSEE went three wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, was urged along late on the backstretch, went three then two wide on the far turn and failed to rally. MISTER MARTI GRAS was eased back to the rear early, raced in the two path on the first turn, lagged at the back, was urged along while two then three wide on the far turn and was no factor. Following the race, the rider of GRAND CONTENDER claimed foul against the winner for alleged interference in deep stretch. After the
