**CALL OF A LION**, steadied behind horses near the four and a half furlongs pole, advanced along the rail entering the stretch, angled out near the eighth pole, closed on her left lead and narrowly prevailed. **ON BOARD CHARADE** stalked the pace, was four wide entering the stretch, gained a short lead near the eighth pole, drifted in, drifted out and just missed in a game effort. **LADDER TO THE MOON**, very wide entering the stretch, rallied. **CENTRIPETAL MOTION** chased the pace three wide, bid for the lead in upper stretch, drifted in on rivals approaching the eighth pole and weakened. **LADY OUTFLANKER** lacked speed, raced very wide in upper stretch then passed tired foes. **GIN SWEEP** prompted the pace two wide between horses, challenged for the lead entering the stretch, was in tight quarters approaching the eighth pole and weakened. **STAR MONEY**, in the four path between horses in upper stretch, failed to rally. **WILD KAY** saved ground, showed speed, was in tight quarters along the rail in midstretch then weakened. **TOUGH TALKIN LADY** chased the pace, came into the stretch in the two path then faltered. **DANCED ALL NIGHT**, very wide turning for home, was not a factor. **OUR JAKS** raced between horses and gave way. **CHANCE REVIEW** trailed.
