JONESIN FOR JERRY was steadied when keen to go on behind rivals approaching the four and a half furlong marker, shifted out, made a sharp three wide move within herself to take over three furlongs out, quickly opened up and proved much the best without being asked in the lane. STEADY N LOVE, off the rail early, was angled in around the turn to give pursuit, eased off the rail in upper stretch and closed willingly inside a rival to just get the place. POCKET GIFT bobbed at the break, recovered and prompted the early pace inside of WEEKENDS FOR LOVE, angled out leaving the three and a half furlong pole, made a slight four wide run into the lane, flattened out late and just lost the place. WEEKENDS FOR LOVE sprinted clear soon after the break, set the early pace off the rail, was overtaken after three furlongs, chased the winner to the head of the lane then gave way. STEELERSOVERRAVENS saved ground without threatening. RAVEN ALEXA was outrun while three wide into the lane. SWEET SOLILOQUY bobbed at the break and failed to keep pace. QUEEN TATALINA circled four wide into the lane while outrun.
