GLIB prompted the pace three wide under rating, cruised to command near the three eighths pole, kicked clear mid turn, opened up under energetic urging in mid stretch then coasted home through the final sixteenth. COACH FRIDGE, away alertly, was taken to rate early while removed from the inside, made steady progress four wide approaching the stretch and continued on willingly to out finish WON THE WAR for the place. WON THE WAR, four wide early, made a three wide run under strong urging nearing the quarter pole, chased the winner past the eighth pole then flattened out late. JACK'S IN THE DECK, outrun early while between rivals, swung out four wide entering the lane and finished with interest. LOVE THOSE BOOTS disputed the early pace inside THREEANDDONEDAN, eased out some mid turn, chased the winner to mid stretch then gave way. SENOR QUICKIE, nudged along early, dropped well off the pace nearing the turn, came three wide for the drive, finished with interest and galloped out well. BULL H, away alertly, angled in early turn, was put to solid pressure mid turn, angled out entering the lane but lacked a rally. LEGENDOFSPARTICUS broke slowly, was outrun early between rivals, entered the lane under a ride but failed to respond. C V OUTLAW, four wide, failed to menace. AIRSTREAM DRIVER lacked speed, circled five wide into the lane and failed to generate a run. THREEANDDONEDAN dueled two wide on a short lead, was overtaken nearing the three eighths pole, chased the winner to the quarter pole then surrendered. SUN SONG saved ground in a forward position for a half mile and weakened. CHAMP'S METAL, inside, was outrun.
