REGAL SOLO rated early while saving ground, angled out when commencing a run leaving the three eighths pole, worked his way between rivals from the eighth pole to the sixteenth

marker, shifted in late and finished gamely inside the winner. SANDBAGIN LOVER eased back off the pace nearing the turn, angled out mid

turn, rallied five wide approaching the furlong pole, angled out wider inside the sixteenth marker and continued on well. MASS DESTRUCTION dueled two wide inside JACK ON THE ROCKS, held a slim advantage into the stretch, came out out some leaving the eighth pole and gave way grudgingly. JACK ON THE ROCKS, away alertly, dueled three wide, battled between rivals in upper stretch, steadied briefly when in close just past the eighth pole and weakened. KNIGHT IN ARMOUR, taken to rate off the pace, circled seven wide into the stretch and had some belated action. LOVE TALK, outrun early, came four to five wide for the drive but lacked a solid response. HOOLIHAN broke a step slow and was outrun. NOT FOR MONEY forced the early pace along the rail and gave way.
