POCKET PATCH chased the early pace, gained a clear lead midway on the backstretch, set the pace well off the rail, responded when asked approaching the eighth pole and eagerly increased his advantage under brisk urging. DAY FLIGHT lacked speed, was well wide leaving the backstretch, entered the stretch in the six path and rallied. HAM AND ERNIE lacked speed three wide the first turn, raced in the two path through the stretch and rallied. ACTION ANDY set the early pace, lost the lead on the backstretch two wide, chased the winner to midstretch then weakened. TARGET SIGHTED raced between horses the far turn and failed to rally. IRISH LION hugged the rail, failed to rally and fell past the wire. ROADHOG lacked speed, advanced in the five path entering the stretch, lugged in near the three sixteenths pole then gave way. DIP MY BEAK, four wide between horses entering the stretch, gave way. BOWMAN'S BOY, unhurried between horses early, was not a factor. PRIDE OF THE FLEET was outrun. CADRE, a forward factor early, dropped back on the far turn. INTO THE WIND stumbled at the break, was rank early, ran off four wide leaving the first turn, stopped and was eased late.
