KING KREESEA broke out at the start and was corrected making minor contact with KHARAFa, briefly was on the front but opted to settle just off the inside tracking ABILIO, remained in hand until nearing the quarter pole as the pressure intensified, took over the front narrowly spinning just off the inside for home roused for the drive, inched away to the eighth pole, offered up good kick under challenge through the final eighth and held sway driving. LUBASH bobbed at the start, was forwardly placed to track the pace inside from within range, came under urging at the five-sixteenths from the two path, spun three wide for home, rallied with good energy to chase the winner home clear for the place honors. NOTACATBUTALLAMA stumbled slightly just after the start, settled just off the inside towards the rear patiently handled, was given a seam down along the rail approaching the five-sixteenths, came under encouragement in response to the opening, cornered just off the inside into the stretch, rallied belatedly into contention splitting foes late to garner the show in the last jumps. ABILIO ranged up to seize command and cross inside to the two path out of the dog legged turn to the backside, relaxed on the front maintaining a safe advantage, came under coaxing midway on the turn as the pressure increased, was roused nearing the quarter pole, got headed turning for home and kept on mildly inside for the last major share. HEAR THE FOOTSTEPS bumped after the start by COMPLIANCE OFFICER, saved ground in mid pack, got roused swinging just off the inside for home, angled out to the five path a furlong out offering a mild bid. BARREL OF LOVE three wide towards the rear, came under encouragement at the five-sixteenths, angled six wide into upper stretch and passed tired rivals in the lane. MAJESTIC RAFFY three wide in mid pack, came under coaxing at the half mile pole through the turn, spun five wide at the quarter pole and weakened in the stretch. COMPLIANCE OFFICER just off the inside in mid pack, came under urging at the five-sixteenths when squeezed back between foes lightly losing some position, cornered just off the inside into the lane and made no headway. JONRAH three to four wide towards the rear, got coaxed along at the half mile pole, spun five wide into upper stretch and made no impact. KHARAFa forwardly placed three to four wide just off the pace, came under a drive at the five-sixteenths, spun four wide for home and tired in the drive. MISSION APPROVED two to three wide forwardly placed between foes in aim of the front, came under coaxing at the half mile pole, faded from contention through the latter portion of the turn and tired in the stretch.
