SHAKEIRA bumped both sides at the start as rivals broke towards her at the break, settled three to four wide towards the rear, took closer order as the field began to bunch up midway on the far turn, came under urging at the five-sixteenths, swung four to five wide into the stretch, rallied with a good kick to confront the leader inside the final furlong to get up in the final strides and prevail. INIMITABLE ROMANEE broke in at the start bumping SHAKEIRA lightly before being corrected, settled two to three wide within aim of the front, ranged up under her own power to challenge three furlongs out, spun three wide into the stretch roused, battled briefly head to head with ELUSIVE RUMOUR until shaking off that foe nearing the eighth pole, dug in under drive through to the wire but was caught in the final strides and forced to settle for the place honors. ELUSIVE RUMOUR attended the pace from just off the inside, came under urging at the five-sixteenths, took command cornering from the two path into the lane, battled head to head briefly with the aforementioned rival until shaken off nearing the eighth pole, kept on to the wire to just hold for the show from a late closing pair. DREAMING OF CARA three wide towards the rear, came under encouragement at the five-sixteenths, cornered three wide for home, shifted inside a path nearing the furlong grounds, rallied mildly and belatedly for the last major share just missing for the show. LADY'S LUNAR LUCK just off the inside in mid pack, remained patiently handled in between foes from the five-sixteenths to the quarter pole, attempted to lean her way out for room on SHAKEIRA swinging four wide into the lane to no avail, offered up a mild kick in the late stages but was out kicked to the line. MANERO rank early on under restraint when keen to go on out of the dog leg turn into the backside, settled tracking along the fence within range of the front, came under light coaxing nearing the quarter pole, angled three wide at that station and offered no response. ADRIATIC DREAM off a beat slow at the start when hesitating, settled four wide towards the rear early on, shifted to the rail at the half mile pole saving ground through the far turn, came under urging three furlongs out, made little headway and weakened in the stretch. LADY CANDIDATE broke out at the start bumping SHAKEIRA, established the pace along the inside in hand, came under pressure midway on the far turn and was placed to light coaxing, got headed just past the five-sixteenths, was placed to a drive cutting the corner into the stretch and faltered.
